Back by popular demand, we held our Secret Santa, in which children were able to do their own Christmas shopping!!! A lot of hard work went into the selection and wrapping of the

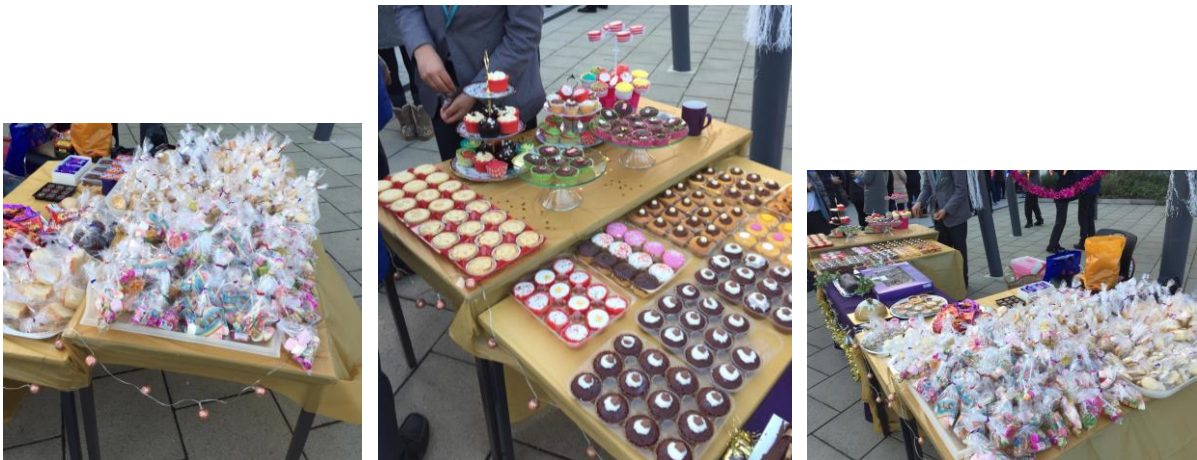
presents, not to mention the logistics of having the children collect their presents. From this event we were able to raise a fantastic £457.18.
